Notes for Memorial Day: What is a Hero?

Hebrew & Greek pronunciation spelled phonetically

Exodus 20:8 - Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.

"The real hero is the man who fights even though he is scared." - General George Patton

Deuteronomy 16:1 - Observe the month of Abib and keep the Passover to the Lord your God, for in the month of Abib the Lord your God brought you out of Egypt by night

Abib (Ah-veev in Hebrew) is now called Nisan (Nee-Sahn) and roughly equates to a period beginning in March and ending in April.

1 Corinthians 11:24-25 - ...and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, "This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me. In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

John 15:13 - "Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends."

Hebrews 13:3 -Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them, and those who are mistreated, since you also are in the body.

1 Corinthians 1:26-29 - For consider your calling, brothers: not many of you were wise according to worldly standards, not many were powerful, not many were of noble birth. But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong; God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, so that no human being might boast in the presence of God.

Romans 4:20 - "No unbelief made him waver concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong in his faith as he gave glory to God,"

Hebrews 11:6 - And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.

Romans 10:17 - So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God Hebrews 11:13-14 - These all died in faith, not having received the things promised, but having seen them and greeted them from afar, and having acknowledged that they were strangers and exiles on the earth.
